The Kitchen

1. Under the sink
2. Around the base of the sink
3. In the garbage disposal
4. Around window frames
5. Beneath or behind appliances (like the fridge)

The Bathroom

6. Under the sink
7. Around the base of the sink
8. On grout tile (floor and shower)
9. On caulking around the tub/shower
10. Around, within, or behind the toilet

The Living Room/Bedrooms

11. On or in overwatered plant soil
12. On the back of upholstered furniture
13. Behind furniture
14. Beneath wood flooring pieces
15. Within carpet fibers
16. Around doorways
17. Around window frames
18. On curtain fabric

The Attic

19. On attic insulation
20. Along water damaged wood beams
21. On ceiling/roof panels
22. On moist paper or cardboard products

All Around the Home

23. On ceiling tiles
24. On vents
25. Within wall insulation
26. Within air ducts
27. Beneath wallpaper
28. On drywall
29. On painted surfaces
30. Inside the gaskets of front-loading washing machines
